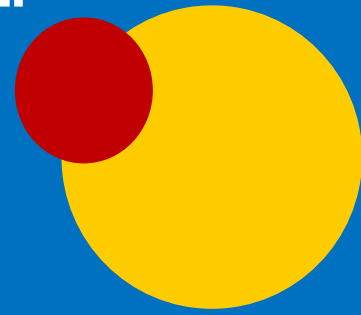

Student Leaders are excited to take responsibility for this fundraiser, promoting it, leading the school and organisation of the entire event.

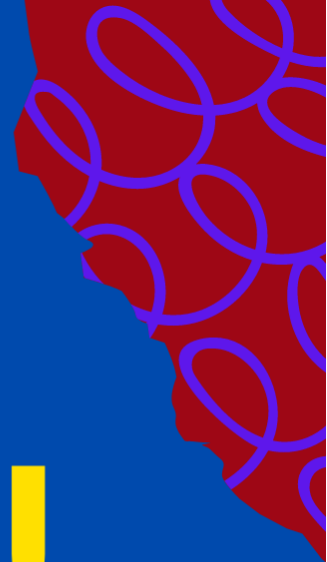
