NEW CHILDCARE PACKAGE

Commences July 2018

The Australian Government is rolling out a new childcare Package; *Jobs for families* to be implemented from July 2018. This package will replace the current Childcare Assistance Scheme, including the childcare benefit and childcare rebate. The new package will make the childcare system more flexible, more accessible, more affordable and targeted to those who need it most. Families are strongly encouraged to familiarise themselves with this new initiative and the new requirements for families and services well before it rolls out in July 2018.
