NEW Child Care Subsidy System (CCSS)

The Australian Government is rolling out a new childcare Package;

Jobs for families to be implemented from July 2018. This package will replace the current Childcare Assistance Scheme, including the childcare benefit and childcare rebate. The new package will make the childcare system more flexible, more accessible, more affordable and targeted to those who need it most. Families are strongly encouraged to familiarise themselves with

this new initiative and the new requirements for families and services well before it rolls out in July 2018.

SOME FAMILIES HAVE STILL NOT REGISTERED UNDER THE NEW SYSTEM!!!

IF YOU HAVE NOT, YOU WILL NOT BE RECEIVING CHILD CARE FEE SUBSIDY AND WILL BE PAYING FULL FEES FROM JULY 2ND 2018.

From July 2nd 2018;

All families will need to be authorize any changes in their childcare usage fortnightly via the MyGov App to continue to receive their subsidies.

FEE INCREASE FOR OSHC

OSHC will be increasing it's fees from 16th July 2018 Term 3;

Aftercare: \$19.00 > \$20.00

Beforecare: \$15.00 > \$16.00

It has been three years since we last increased out fees - so to keep in line with increasing costs to continue to provide a high quality service to our families we have decided to increase our fees by \$1.00 per day per service per .
