IMPORTANT OSHC ADMIN THIS WEEK

- ⇒ Have Families confirmed their income for the 2018-19 financial year—you need to do this by March 31 2021. A factsheet was emailed out to families 19/02.
- ⇒ **Emergency Management**; On Wednesday, We practiced our emergency evacuation fire drill-which went very well. We do these twice per term in each program. We will introduce this to the preps gently. If families could have some supporting conversations with their children at home re; why we need to do these—that would help to alleviate any potential worry.
- ⇒ Fee Increase; Please see page 2 from 22/02
- ⇒ Child Care Subsidy; make sure you have confirmed your booking patterns and have a current and approved status for the Child Care Subsidy (CCS) when you start your OSHC bookings in 2021— if this is not confirmed and up to date in your MyGov account you will not receive the subsidy you are entitled to until you do. There are a few families with missing or incorrect details and/or ceased CCS status. OSHC will also attached messages to your invoices re; your CCS status.
- ⇒ **Medical documentation for OSHC**; we have a number of families that need to provide us with updated medical plans and medication. Could you please make sure that you provide this important and necessary documentation to the OSHC service as soon as possible. If your child has been diagnosed with a medical condition please make sure you update this information in MyFamily Lounge and let OSHC know.

OSHC Fees Increase

In order to continue to provide a high quality and financially viable service, OSHC will be raising fees from 22nd February 2021. Fees were due to be raised in term 1, 2020 but were put on hold due to COVID. Fees will be subject to the Childcare Subsidy fee relief as normal.

ASC: \$20.00 > \$22.00

BSC: \$16.00 > \$17.00

COVID Safe Procedures for Term 1, 2021

OSHC will still be adhering to a COVID Safe Plan for 2021. We still need to continue safe practices and have plans in place to keep COVID at bay.

- ⇒ practice safe hygiene, including washing hands and sanitising regularly, routine cleaning of high used areas and resources
- ⇒ Wear mask in public spaces within the school
- ⇒ Families/parents x 1 will be allowed on grounds to sign their children in/out to OSHC
 - Do not enter school grounds if you have any COVID type symptoms
 - Masks must be worn on site
 - must not be on site for longer than 15 minutes
 - enter the OSHC room with a mask on, hand sanitise before signing the children in/ out via the kiosk IPADS.
 - wait at the gate if you are going to be longer than 15 minutes

- Children are to be picked up by authorized contacts only.

The Child Care Subsidy System (CCS) & Government Compliance

Have you confirmed your booking pattern in your MyGov account?

- You must do this every time you make any changes to your circumstances or booking patterns. CCS will automatically 'cease' if you have not use the program for 14 weeks
- Check your subsidy regularly to make sure you are receiving the correct subsidy and hours you are entitled too.

OSHC Invoices

All OSHC payments are made via the Qkr! Mastercard App downloaded from Google play/App store.

OSHC Invoices are sent out fortnightly and are expected to be paid on a regular fortnightly basis.

Signing your child in and out of OSHC

We use a digital sign in system; *Qikkids Kiosk*, you will need to enter you mobile phone number and then set-up a 4 digit PIN number which you will use for all your OSHC signing in and out. Your Authorised contacts also use this system —they can set-up their own PIN but need to be authorised by you on your MyFamily lounge account.


