


Child Care Subsidy Information

We can only pay your Child Care Subsidy (CCS) if your child's enrolment is current.

Estimate your 2024-25 family income

You need to estimate your family income, so we pay you the right amount of Family Tax Benefit (FTB) and CCS. If you get FTB or CCS, you need to tell us how much your and your partner's income will be for the 2024–25 financial year.

What staff have been working on



Our team has currently been working on updating some of our policies and risk assessmens, to ensure that children and young people in our care are protected and safe. In our last staff meeting, we focused particularly on the 'Safe Arrival of Children' and identifying potential hazards and risks.

'Safe Arrival of Children' was created in regards to new legislative requirements of safe arrival of children who travel between an education and care service (i.e. the school) and any other education or early learning service (i.e. OSHC). It requires careful planning to ensure that children's health, wellbing and safety are maintained while this transition occurs.

At BEPS OSHC, this entails chatting to teachers as they bring children over to us and recieving updates of how the students' days have gone, signing children in on our iPads, greeting and chatting to children, doing head counts, tracking down any missing children, etc.

This week, we also conducted questionnaires with children attending OSHC (with the help of some of the children) during the afternoons in order to assess their understanding of safe arrival. We asked them "When we finish at school, we make our way over to OSHC- how do we make sure that we arrive at OSHC safely?". These were some of their responses:

- · "No running in the agora",
- · "Going with the teacher",
- · "Being careful when you are walking out of your classroom",
- · "Don't waste time and go straight to OSHC",
- "Lining up"
- · "Be respectful"

We were incredibly impressed with these responses and it demonstrated to us that the children and young people attending our service has a great understanding of their behavioural expectations and of the physical safety concerns of the transition from school into OSHC.

When brainstorming with staff during our weekly staff meeting, one issue stood out to us in particular, which was families forgetting to tell us that their child will be absent. When we log onto our system to sign children in at 3:30PM, we are expecting to sign every single one of the children, as they are the children we are responsible for caring for until families collect them. When we 'can't locate' children in the afternoon, we have procedures in place to locate the child, for example, Rena will ring our listed contacts for the child, however this can be really difficult if we can't get through to parents for them to then confirm where the child is. ACECQA states that "A child appears to be missing or cannot be accounted for" as a serious incident and requires us to contact them with 24 hours to make a report and in some cases, we may be required to call the police.

It would be incredibly helpful to us moving foward, if families could please contact us if their child has been booked in for a service but won't attend for whatever reason. A quick email or even a text to our OSHC phone number is enough, or even if you quickly stop by aftercare to let a staff member know that your child will be absent that afternoon. :)
