World Environment Day

This year's World Environment Day campaign focuses on land restoration, desertification and drought resilience under the slogan "Our land. Our future. We are #GenerationRestoration."



Sustainability is one of the principles in My Time, Our Place V2.0. The following are some excerpts from MTOP that mention the importance of including sustainability in our OSHC practises.

"Environmental sustainability, which focuses on caring for our natural world and protecting, preserving and improving the environment... Thinking about sustainability means thinking about the future and acting to create healthy, just and vibrant futures for all."

"Educators recognise children and young people's avid interest in their world, their ability to engage with concepts of sustainability and their capacity to advocate and act for positive change."

"Educators encourage children and young people to develop an appreciation of the natural world, understand our impact on the natural world, and the interdependence between people, animals, plants, lands and waters."

We want to be able to provide opportunities for children and young people to learn about all the interconnected dimensions of sustainability, understanding that sustainability goes beyond learning in nature and being involved in nature conservation. Using significant days such as World Environment Day, allows us to focus in on the topic, create activities for the children to participate in, as well as creating space to open up conversation around sustainability and the environment. Often the children teach us educators a thing or two too!
